Dear Sirs

Further to your open letter to us as Co-Leaders for Fife Council we would state our commitment in principle to the intentions behind the stated sustainable goals as adopted by the Scottish Government in 2015 and now promoted through your network approach.

We attach our recently adopted Local Outcome Improvement Plan, Climate Change Plan, and a link for the [Local Development Plan](#) as together this displays the approach to the 17 stated sustainable development goals.

We are advised that the Scottish Government will, it appears, place draft legislation before Parliament soon on the subject. The process, we understand, once the legislation has 'sat' for the required time will then go into various committees for scrutiny before reappearing in due course aligned with the National Performance Framework.

At this time it seems appropriate to state that Fife Council is, in principle, supportive of the goals but awaits the outcome of the parliamentary scrutiny process to ensure that we are all trying to deliver to the same goals in the same way.
